

Privacy Notice for Registration for the Opening Ceremony

Notice pursuant to Art. 13 GDPR for online registration

1. Controller

The controller within the meaning of the General Data Protection Regulation is:

2. Purposes and Legal Basis of Processing

We process your data exclusively for the purpose of organising and conducting the opening ceremony, in particular for:

- Reviewing and managing your registration
- Preparing participant lists and access/organisational lists
- Communication in connection with the event

The processing of registration data is based on Art. 6(1)(b) GDPR, insofar as the registration is understood as a pre-contractual measure or as an organisationally necessary participation procedure, or alternatively on Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR (legitimate interest in conducting the event and proper organisation).

Where you provide information regarding food intolerances, we process this data solely on the basis of your explicit consent pursuant to Art. 6(1)(a) GDPR in conjunction with Art. 9(2)(a) GDPR. Such information is voluntary. You may withdraw your consent at any time with effect for the future.

3. Categories of Personal Data

- First name / Last name
- Academic title
- Company / Organisation
- Position / Function
- Email address
- Phone number (for queries)
- Age of children

4. Recipients of Data

Within the organisation, only those departments responsible for organising the event will have access to the data. Where external service providers are engaged, these may, as processors pursuant to Art. 28 GDPR, have access to the data, in particular in the area of IT/hosting or registration platform services.

Further disclosure to third parties will only take place where this is necessary for the conduct of the event or where a legal obligation exists.

5. Transfer to Third Countries

A transfer to countries outside the EU/EEA will only take place where this is required in connection with the technical service providers used. In such cases, the transfer will only be made in compliance with the statutory requirements of Art. 44 et seq. GDPR, in particular on the basis of an adequacy decision or appropriate safeguards.

6. Retention Period

Data will only be stored for as long as is necessary for the preparation, conduct, and follow-up of the opening ceremony. Upon completion of the event and resolution of all organisational follow-up tasks, the data will be deleted, at the latest 4 weeks after the event, unless statutory retention obligations preclude deletion.

7. Rights of Data Subjects

You have the following rights against the controller, provided the statutory requirements are met:

- Right of access to data stored about you (Art. 15 GDPR)
- Right to rectification of inaccurate data (Art. 16 GDPR)
- Right to erasure of your data (Art. 17 GDPR)
- Right to restriction of processing (Art. 18 GDPR)
- Right to object to processing on the basis of Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR (Art. 21 GDPR)
- Right to withdraw consent granted with effect for the future (Art. 7(3) GDPR)

8. Right to Lodge a Complaint with a Supervisory Authority

You also have the right to lodge a complaint with a data protection supervisory authority, in particular in the federal state of your habitual residence, place of work, or place of the alleged infringement. The competent state authority for CeramTec is located in Baden-Württemberg.

9. Requirement to Provide Data

The provision of the data listed above is required for registration and organisational processing. Without such information, registration for the event will generally not be possible.
