Science Minister Petra Olschowski visits advanced ceramics manufacturer CeramTec

**Plochingen, May 16, 2023** - Petra Olschowski, Minister of Science, Research and the Arts of the State of Baden-Württemberg, visited the hidden champion CeramTec in Plochingen last week.
